# MAPLE SHADE SOCCER CODE OF CONDUCT

The MSSC along with the state and its McGreevey law has a ZERO tolerance with harassment at sporting events. To insure that you understand what we mean, we have created this letter which needs to be signed at the bottom.

First as a reminder, there is no alcoholic beverages allowed at the complex. Also, there is to be no smoking near the fields. Please go out to the parking lot away from the snackstand if you need to smoke.

There is to be NO speaking to, yelling at, degrading or humiliating a referee concerning their calls or ways of handling a game. Most of our referees are still children themselves and should never be confronted by a parent or coach. Any concerns should first be brought before the head coach and then if necessary, the Vice President of the MSSC.

The 7 & 8 yr. old referees are LICENSED referees. They still play the game and know the game better than most parents and some coaches. Soccer may be a contact sport and still played correctly. The MSSC does not endorse pushing or fouling of players. However, there is body to body contact that is allowed while the player is going after the ball. It is the referee's discretion when to make that call. One rule that many don't understand is ADVANTAGE. Your child may get fouled during the game, however, if that child's team still wins the ball then they gained ADVANTAGE and no whistle will be blown. Referee's will see things differently or even make the wrong call. However, they are out there doing their best just like the players.

The 5 & 6 yr. old referees are young players that have been involved with soccer for approximately 8 - 12 years. They do know the game and they try their best. Our goal for this division is to teach them the basic skills and to gain some knowledge into the laws of the game. We ask the referees to teach and direct the players while the game is going on. Some of them are shy and nervous, however, this is a chance for them to see if they can advance to the next level and become licensed. We ask for your patience and understanding as mistakes may happen. Keep in mind that one day your little player may be reffing these games and will deserve the same respect.

The players should not have to see spectators or coaches acting like they are "out for blood." They play this sport for their enjoyment and not yours. If you cannot show support for ALL players, and keep in mind that they are all friends and families that live amongst each other in town, then do not attend the games.

Please inform any fans coming to cheer on your child that anyone acting in an improper manor will be asked to leave the fields. If there is any objection, the police will be called and the game will not continue until they are escorted off the premises. The McGreevey law, bill A-446 states, violators would only be allowed to return if they complete a sports violence counseling program.

Travel League - Keep in mind that if you become a violator, the referee will card your players coach and the fee that is imposed upon the team will be your responsibility.

We thank you for your support in this matter on behalf of all players, parents, coaches, & referees of the Maple Shade Soccer Club.
